ACTS 2:1 = *On the day of Pentecost all the believers were meeting together in one place.*

PENTECOST: What Happened?

ACTS 2:2-3 = ²*Suddenly, there was a sound from heaven like the roaring of a mighty windstorm, and it filled the house where they were sitting.* ³*Then, what looked like flames or tongues of fire appeared and settled on each of them.*

#1 = The Spirit _____

JOHN 14:16-17 = ¹⁶*And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Advocate, who will never leave you.* ¹⁷*He is the Holy Spirit, who leads into all truth. The world cannot receive him, because it isn't looking for him and doesn't recognize him. But you know him, because he lives with you now and later will be in you.*

LUKE 24:53 = ⁵³*And they spent all of their time in the Temple, praising God.*

ACTS 1:5 = ⁵*John baptized with water, but in just a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit."*

1 CORINTHIANS 12:12-13 = ¹²*The human body has many parts, but the many parts make up one whole body. So it is with the body of Christ.* ¹³*Some of us are Jews, some are Gentiles, some are slaves, and some are free. But we have all been baptized into one body by one Spirit, and we all share the same Spirit.*

ACTS 2:4 = ⁴*And everyone present was filled with the Holy Spirit and began speaking in other languages, as the Holy Spirit gave them this ability.*

ACTS 2:5-13 = ⁵*At that time there were devout Jews from every nation living in Jerusalem.* ⁶*When they heard the loud noise, everyone came running, and they were bewildered to hear their own languages being spoken by the believers.* ⁷*They were completely amazed. "How can this be?" they exclaimed. "These people are all from Galilee,* ⁸*and yet we hear them speaking in our own native languages!* ⁹*Here we are—Parthians, Medes, Elamites, people from Mesopotamia, Judea, Cappadocia, Pontus, the province of Asia,* ¹⁰*Phrygia, Pamphylia, Egypt, and the areas of Libya around Cyrene, visitors from Rome* ¹¹*(both Jews and converts to Judaism), Cretans, and Arabs. And we all hear these people speaking in our own languages about the wonderful things God has done!"* ¹²*They stood there amazed and perplexed. "What can this mean?" they asked each other.* ¹³*But others in the crowd ridiculed them, saying, "They're just drunk, that's all!"*

ACTS 1:8 = ⁸*But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you. And you will be my witnesses, telling people about me everywhere—in Jerusalem, throughout Judea, in Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."*
