MATTHEW 22:37-39 = ³⁷ Jesus replied, "You must love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your mind." ³⁸ This is the first and greatest commandment. ³⁹ A second is equally important: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.'

Heart Attitude #1 = Put the Goals and Interests of Others Before My Own

PHILIPPIANS 2:1-2 = *Is there any encouragement from belonging to Christ? Any comfort from his love? Any fellowship together in the Spirit? Are your hearts tender and compassionate?* ² Then make me truly happy by agreeing wholeheartedly with each other, loving one another, and working together with one mind and purpose.

PHILIPPIANS 2:3-4 = ³ Don't be selfish; don't try to impress others. Be humble, thinking of others as better than yourselves. ⁴ Don't look out only for your own interests, but take an interest in others, too.

PHILIPPIANS 2:5-6 = ⁵ You must have the same attitude that Christ Jesus had. ⁶ Though he was God, he did not think of equality with God as something to cling to.

PHILIPPIANS 2:7a = ⁷ Instead, he gave up his divine privileges; he took the humble position of a slave and was born as a human being.

MATTHEW 20:28 = ²⁸ For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve others and to give his life as a ransom for many."

#3 = He _____

PHILIPPIANS 2:7b-8 = *When he appeared in human form,* ⁸ he humbled himself in obedience to God and died a criminal's death on a cross.

LUKE 9:23 = ²³ Then he said to the crowd, "If any of you wants to be my follower, you must give up your own way, take up your cross daily, and follow me.

#4 = He _____ God

PHILIPPIANS 2:9-11 = ⁹ Therefore, God elevated him to the place of highest honor and gave him the name above all other names, ¹⁰ that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, ¹¹ and every tongue declare that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

1 PETER 5:5b-6 = *And all of you, dress yourselves in humility as you relate to one another, for "God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble."* ⁶ So humble yourselves under the mighty power of God, and at the right time he will lift you up in honor.
